A Resolution

A Resolution establishing Student Performance Targets and Reporting Procedures in the National Minimum Competency Test (NMCT) in Reading for 2010-2011.

WHEREAS, the 2010 NMCT reading assessment data shows that 29% of Grade 6, 35% of Grade 8 and 39% of Grade 10 students' performance levels were in the Competent or Minimally Competent level;

WHEREAS all test items are closely aligned with the National Curriculum Standards and Benchmarks;


WHEREAS the expectation is that all students should attain the skills, knowledge and understanding described in the National Curriculum Standards and Benchmarks;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by FACSSO that the National Department of Education and the State Departments of Education shall collaborate on the implementation of measures aimed at raising the level of student performance in the NMCT so that in 2011, student performance at Competent and Minimally Competent in all NMCT's in all states will increase by 20%;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the National Department of Education shall provide technical assistance to States in the interpretation of 2010 test results and the preparation of individual student reports and that the State Departments of Education shall conduct school-based meetings to convey the 2010 test results to parents and distribute individual student reports to the parents or guardians of all students who took the test;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT by June 30, 2011, State Directors of Education shall submit to the Secretary of Education a report showing the number of school meetings conducted and the number of individual student reports distributed to the parents or guardians of all students who took the test




