A Resolution

WHEREAS, the FSM President and the four State Governors that made up the members of the Chief Executive Committee of 2008 endorsed through a communiqué the development of a "separate learning track" for the career and technical education in the nation to train and prepare the high school students and out-of-school youths toward the local workforce; and

WHEREAS, a career and technical education curriculum standard and benchmark was developed in 2008 as an initiative to support and provide for the improvement of career and technical education; and


WHEREAS, the development of a career guidance and career placement program be established to support the students who are in career and technical education; and

WHEREAS, the development of an aptitude test for seniors and career guidance counseling guideline for career and technical education are currently underway which may eventually become essential component of the learning pathway; and NOW THEREFORE,






